



**Transfer of parsonage house**

9. The parsonage house of the benefice of The Holy Trinity, Ashby-de-la-Zouch, together with the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds usually occupied and enjoyed therewith, shall without any conveyance or other assurance be transferred to the Leicester Diocesan Board of Finance to be held by the said Board as part of the diocesan glebe land of the diocese of Leicester.

**Disposal of parsonage house**

10. The parsonage house of the benefice of Breedon-on-the-Hill cum Isley Walton and Worthington, together with the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds usually occupied and enjoyed therewith, shall without any conveyance or other assurance be transferred to the Leicester Diocesan Board of Finance for disposal in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 9 of Schedule 3 to the Pastoral Measure 1983.

**Coming into operation of this Scheme**

11. This Scheme shall come into operation upon the first day of the month following the date of any Order of Her Majesty in Council confirming this Scheme.

**SCHEDULE TO THE SCHEME**

**Constitution of the Ashby and Breedon Team Ministry Patronage Board**

The patronage board referred to in clause 5 of this Scheme shall consist of:-

- (1) the Bishop of Leicester in his corporate capacity, who shall be chairman of the board and shall have one vote;
- (2) Donald Alexander Gillies Sheilds, Esquire, of Flatts Stile, Parwich, Ashbourne, Derby. DE6 1QJ, who shall have one vote;
- (3) The Master or Keeper of Christ's College in the University of Cambridge with the Fellows and Scholars of the same, who shall have one vote.

## PASTORAL SCHEME

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners this 10th day of January 2005 in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983, the Right Reverend Timothy, Bishop of Leicester, having consented thereto.

### Union of benefices

1. The benefice of Ashby-de-la-Zouch Saint Helen with Cole Orton; the benefice of The Holy Trinity, Ashby-de-la-Zouch and the benefice of Breedon-on-the-Hill cum Isley Walton and Worthington in the diocese of Leicester shall be united to create a new benefice which shall be named "The Benefice of Ashby-de-la-Zouch and Breedon on the Hill", and the area of the new benefice shall comprise the parish of Ashby-de-la-Zouch, the parish of Cole Orton, the parish of The Holy Trinity, Ashby-de-la-Zouch, the parish of Breedon-on-the-Hill; the parish of Isley Walton and the parish of Worthington, which parishes shall continue distinct.

### Archdeaconry and deanery

2. The new benefice and its constituent parishes shall belong to the archdeaconry of Loughborough and the deanery of Akeley West (Ashby).

### Establishment of team ministry

3. (1) A team ministry (to be known as "The Ashby and Breedon Team Ministry") shall be established for the area of the new benefice.

(2) The cure of souls in that area shall be shared by the incumbent of the new benefice, whose office shall be that of rector in the team ministry, and one other minister, who shall have the title of vicar and a status equal to that of an incumbent of a benefice.

(3) That area shall be in the pastoral care of those who are to share the cure of souls therein together with all other persons who are from time to time authorised by licence or permission of the Bishop to serve in that area as members of the team.

### The office of rector in the team ministry

4. The office of rector in the team ministry shall be held by each holder thereof for a term of seven years, and if immediately before this Scheme comes into operation the Reverend Brian Ainsley Robertson is licensed by the Bishop to serve within the area of any of the benefices referred to in clause 1 of this Scheme he shall be the first rector.

### Presentation of rector

5. Subject to clause 4 hereof, the rector shall be presented by a patronage board (to be known as "The Ashby and Breedon Team Ministry Patronage Board") constituted in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule hereto.

### The office of vicar in the team ministry

6. (1) The vicar in the team ministry shall be chosen by the Bishop and the rector jointly.

(2) The office of vicar shall be held by the holder thereof for a term of seven years and the licence of the Bishop under his episcopal seal appointing the holder thereto may (subject to variation or revocation of any such provision with the consent of the rector and the vicar by subsequent licence under seal) -

- (a) assign to the vicar a special cure of souls in respect of a part of the said area and, if appropriate, the name of vicar of a church in that part;
- (b) assign to the vicar a special responsibility for a particular pastoral function;
- (c) provide that any such special cure or responsibility shall be independent of the rector's general responsibility;
- (d) assign to the vicar a general responsibility to be shared with the rector for the cure of souls in the said area as a whole.

### Team council

7. (1) The Bishop may by Instrument under his hand, with the concurrence of the rector, make provision -

- (a) for the establishment of a team council;
- (b) for the chairmanship, meetings and procedure of the team council;
- (c) for the functions of the parochial church council of each parish in the area of the new benefice which must or may be delegated to the team council;

being provisions to the same effect as those which may be made by a Scheme under the Church Representation Rules in the like case.

(2) The provisions of clause 7(1) hereof relating to the establishment of a team council shall cease to apply after a period of five years from the date of the establishment of the team ministry.

### Places of residence

8. (1) The parsonage house of the benefice of Ashby-de-la-Zouch Saint Helen with Cole Orton shall be the parsonage house of the new benefice.

(2) Subject to the direction of the Bishop given from time to time after consultation with the rector and vicar in the team ministry, the said rector and vicar shall severally reside in:-

- (a) the parsonage house of benefice of Ashby-de-la-Zouch Saint Helen with Cole Orton;
- (b) the parsonage house of the benefice of The Holy Trinity, Ashby-de-la-Zouch;
- (c) such other conveniently situated house or houses as may, with the Bishop's approval, be provided in substitution therefor.
